- 1.2relating to children; appropriating money for improvements to the Social Services
- 1.3Information System.
- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; SOCIAL SERVICES INFORMATION SYSTEM.**
- 1.6\$40,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
- 1.7of children, youth, and families for information technology improvements to the Social
- 1.8Services Information System (SSIS). Money appropriated under this section must be used
- 1.9to develop and implement a modernization plan or replacement for SSIS. Improvements
- 1.10must be developed through collaborative planning with counties and Tribal Nations that
- 1.11use SSIS and must have a direct impact on child welfare casework. The appropriation must
- 1.12not be used for changes to SSIS that are not part of the modernization plan or for other
- 1.13Department of Human Services or Department of Children, Youth, and Families information
- 1.14technology systems. This is a onetime appropriation.
