1.3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.4	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; ISUROON.
1.5	(a) \$2,500,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage
1.6	fund to the commissioner of administration for a grant to Isuroon, a nonprofit organization
1.7	dedicated to empowering ethnic women through cultural preservation, social connection,
1.8	and mental wellness initiatives.
1.9	(b) The money must be used to support arts, cultural heritage, and wellness programs
1.10	tailored specifically to ethnic women through:
1.11	(1) annual arts and culture celebrations that uplift ethnic women's voices through music,
1.12	dance, storytelling, and visual arts;
1.13	(2) public art installations and exhibitions showcasing the artistic contributions of ethnic
1.14	women in Minnesota;
1.15	(3) culturally responsive workshops and educational programs designed to engage ethnic
1.16	women and girls in traditional and contemporary artistic practices;
1.17	(4) programs that foster social connections and mental wellness by providing safe spaces
1.18	for ethnic women to express themselves through art, dance, and community gatherings;
1.19	(5) healing-centered cultural activities that promote emotional well-being and resilience,
