1.7	(a) \$ in fiscal year 2026 and \$ in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from the
1.8	clean water fund to the Board of Water and Soil Resources for grants to soil and water
1.9	conservation districts in the counties of Dodge, Fillmore, Freeborn, Goodhue, Houston,
1.10	Mower, Olmsted, Rice, Steele, Wabasha, and Winona to reduce leaching of excess crop
1.11	nutrients into groundwater, immobilize unused nitrogen from the rooting zone, and reduce
1.12	erosion as part of a new southeast regional groundwater protection and soil health initiative.
