BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. NEW AUBURN; STORMWATER, WASTEWATER, AND DRINKING
- 1.7

WATER INFRASTRUCTURE.
- 1.8

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$9,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.9

to the public facilities authority for a grant to the city of New Auburn to predesign, design,
- 1.10

engineer, construct, and equip stormwater, wastewater, and drinking water infrastructure.
- 1.11

This appropriation includes money for improvements to or replacement of municipal:
- 1.12

wastewater ponds, spray irrigation and sanitary sewer systems, and associated infrastructure;
- 1.13

storm sewer systems and associated infrastructure to better drain areas of the community;
- 1.14

and water main distribution systems and associated infrastructure to provide for improved
- 1.15

water quality, water flow, fire protection and water accountability.
- 1.16

Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.17

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.18

the state in an amount up to \$9,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.19

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
