1.2relating to state government; requiring a notice on state-funded advertising; creating

1.3civil personal liability for failure to comply; proposing coding for new law in

1.4Minnesota Statutes, chapter 15.

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. [15.442] NOTICE ON ADVERTISING.

1.7Subdivision 1. Notice required. An advertisement placed or promotional material

1.8distributed by a state agency or constitutional officer that is produced with state funds or is

1.9aired or presented on media time or space that is purchased with state funds must prominently

1.10contain the message, "Paid for by the hardworking taxpayers of Minnesota." This requirement

1.11applies to advertisements placed through any medium, including radio, television, print,

1.12websites, or social media. The required message in a radio advertisement must be in audio

1.13form. The required message in an advertisement in video form must be presented as text

1.14and in audio form. The required message in an advertisement in print media must be

1.15prominently displayed as text.

1.16Subd. 2. Liability for failure to comply. The commissioner of an agency or a

1.17constitutional officer for an office that places an advertisement or distributes promotional

1.18material that does not comply with the message requirement in subdivision 1 is personally

1.19liable to the state for the cost of producing and placing the advertisement. Penalties paid

1.20under this subdivision are deposited into the general fund.
