1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[609.077] IMMUNITY; BAR TO PROSECUTION; CERTAIN ACTIONS**

1.7 **BY PREGNANT PERSON.**

1.8 A pregnant person may not be charged with or convicted of a crime for conduct that

1.9 would not be criminalized if the same person was not pregnant including but not limited to

1.10 the use of drugs, prescribed or otherwise; experiencing abuse; exposure to or being a victim

1.11 of domestic or other violence; or failing to maintain optimal physical health.
