BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.4 Section 1. [121A.12] DISPLAY OF TEN COMMANDMENTS. 1.5 (a) A public elementary or secondary school shall display in a conspicuous place in each 1.6 classroom of the school a durable poster or framed copy of the Ten Commandments that 1.7 meets the requirements of paragraph (b). 1.8 (b) A poster or framed copy of the Ten Commandments must: 1.9 (1) include the text of the Ten Commandments as provided by paragraph (c) in a size 1.10 and typeface that is legible to a person with average vision from anywhere in the classroom 1.11 in which the poster or framed copy is displayed; and 1.12 (2) be at least 16 inches wide and 20 inches tall. 1.13 (c) The text of the poster or framed copy of the Ten Commandments must read as follows: 1.14 "The Ten Commandments 1.15 I AM the LORD thy God. Thou shalt have no other gods before me. 1.16 Thou shalt not make to thyself any graven images. 1.17 Thou shalt not take the Name of the Lord thy God in vain. 1.18 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. 1.19
