Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 144E.123, subdivision 3, is amended to read: 1.5 Subd. 3. Review. Prehospital care data may be reviewed by the director or its designees. 1.6 The data shall be classified as private data on individuals under chapter 13, the Minnesota 1.7 Government Data Practices Act. The director may share with the Washington/Baltimore 1.8 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area's Overdose Detection Mapping Application Program 1.9 (ODMAP) data that identifies where and when an overdose incident happens, fatality status, 1.10 suspected drug type, naloxone administration, and first responder type.
