1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 144.145, is amended to read:
1.6	144.145 FLUORIDATION OF MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLIES.
1.7	(a) For the purpose of promoting public health through prevention of tooth decay, the
1.8	person, firm, corporation, or municipality having jurisdiction over a municipal public water
1.9	supply, whether publicly or privately owned or operated, shall control:
1.10	(1) whether to fluoridate the public water supply; and
1.11	(2) the quantities of fluoride in the water in a public water supply that opts to fluoridate
1.12	so as to maintain a fluoride content that is within the parameters prescribed by the state
1.13	commissioner of health. In the manner provided by law,
1.14	(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a person, firm, corporation, or municipality having
1.15	jurisdiction over a public water supply must not fluoridate water that contains naturally

1.19	(1) promulgate rules according to chapter 14 relating to the fluoridation of public water
