BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; FENCING CONSORTIUM.**
- 1.6

\$3,500,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
- 1.7

of public safety for a grant to the Fencing Consortium for acquisition of anti-scale fencing,
- 1.8

pedestrian doors, and vehicle gates for local government facilities statewide that are members
- 1.9

of the consortium to improve equitable access to a de-escalation and safety tool. This

appropriation is available until the project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota

Statutes, section 16A.642. This is a onetime appropriation.
