1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for anti-scale fencing, pedestrian

1.3 doors, and vehicle gates.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; FENCING CONSORTIUM.**

1.6 \$3,500,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7 of public safety for a grant to the Fencing Consortium for acquisition of anti-scale fencing,

1.8 pedestrian doors, and vehicle gates for local government facilities statewide that are members

1.9 of the consortium to improve equitable access to a de-escalation and safety tool. This

1.10 appropriation is available until the project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota

1.11 Statutes, section 16A.642. This is a onetime appropriation.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
