OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; extending the availability of the appropriation for an
1.3 engagement services pilot grant; amending Laws 2024, chapter 127, article 53,
1.4 section 2, subdivision 15.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2024, chapter 127, article 53, section 2, subdivision 15, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 15. **Grant Programs; Adult Mental Health**
1.9 **Grants** (8,900,000) 2,364,000

1.10 (a) **Locked Intensive Residential Treatment**
1.11 **Services.** \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 is for
1.12 start-up funds to intensive residential treatment
1.13 services providers to provide treatment in
1.14 locked facilities for patients meeting medical
1.15 necessity criteria and who may also be referred
1.16 for competency attainment or a competency
1.17 examination under Minnesota Statutes,
1.18 sections 611.40 to 611.59. This is a onetime
1.19 appropriation. Notwithstanding Minnesota
1.20 Statutes, section 16A.28, subdivision 3, this
1.21 appropriation is available until June 30, 2027.

1.22 (b) **Engagement Services Pilot Grants.**
1.23 \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2025 is for

2.1 engagement services pilot grants. Of this
2.2 amount, \$250,000 in fiscal year 2025 is for an
2.3 engagement services pilot grant to Otter Tail
2.4 County. This is a onetime appropriation.
2.5 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section
2.6 16A.28, subdivision 3, this appropriation is
2.7 available until June 30, ~~2026~~ 2028.

2.8 **(c) Mental Health Innovation Grant**
2.9 **Program.** \$1,321,000 in fiscal year 2025 is
2.10 for the mental health innovation grant program
2.11 under Minnesota Statutes, section 245.4662.
2.12 This is a onetime appropriation.
2.13 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section
2.14 16A.28, subdivision 3, this appropriation is
2.15 available until June 30, 2026.

2.16 **(d) Behavioral Health Services For**
2.17 **Immigrant And Refugee Communities.**
2.18 \$354,000 in fiscal year 2025 is for a payment
2.19 to African Immigrant Community Services to
2.20 provide culturally and linguistically
2.21 appropriate services to new Americans with
2.22 disabilities, mental health needs, and substance
2.23 use disorders and to connect such individuals
2.24 with appropriate alternative service providers
2.25 to ensure continuity of care. This is a onetime
2.26 appropriation. Notwithstanding Minnesota
2.27 Statutes, section 16A.28, subdivision 3, this
2.28 appropriation is available until June 30, 2027.

2.29 **(e) Base Level Adjustment.** The general fund
2.30 base is decreased by \$1,811,000 in fiscal year
2.31 2026 and decreased by \$1,811,000 in fiscal
2.32 year 2027.
