1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the Redpath impoundment

1.3flood hazard mitigation project; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **FLOOD HAZARD MITIGATION; REDPATH IMPOUNDMENT.**

1.6Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** (a) \$13,700,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.7fund to the commissioner of natural resources for the state share of flood hazard mitigation

1.8grants for publicly owned capital improvements to prevent or alleviate flood damage under

1.9Minnesota Statutes, section 103F.161.

1.10(b) Levee projects, to the extent practical, shall meet the state standard of three feet

1.11above the 100-year flood elevation.

1.12(c) Project priorities shall be determined by the commissioner as appropriate and based

1.13on need.

1.14(d) This appropriation is for the Redpath impoundment project sponsored by the Bois

1.15de Sioux Watershed District.

1.16(e) For any project listed in this subdivision that the commissioner determines is not

1.17ready to proceed or does not expend all the money allocated to it, the commissioner may

1.18allocate that project's money to a project on the commissioner's priority list.

1.19(f) To the extent that the cost of a project exceeds two percent of the median household

1.20income in a municipality or township multiplied by the number of households in the

1.21municipality or township, this appropriation is also for the local share of the project.

2.1        Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond  
2.2        proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of  
2.3        the state in an amount up to \$13,700,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect  
2.4        prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota  
2.5        Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

2.6        **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
