Section 1. [116P.22] CHILD PROTECTION BACKGROUND CHECKS.

As part of the work plan required by section 116P.05, subdivision 2, a recipient of an 1.8 appropriation from the trust fund that is a children's service provider, as defined in section 1.9 299C.61, subdivision 5, must certify to the commission that it performs criminal background 1.10 checks on all employees, contractors, and volunteers that have or may have access to a child 1.11 to whom the recipient provides children's services. 1.12

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2025, and applies to a recipient 1.13 of money appropriated on or after that date. 1.14
