1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. [145.4225] PROHIBITED TREATMENTS FOR GENDER DYSPHORIA

1.7IN MINORS.

1.8(a) All licensed or regulated health care providers are prohibited from the following

1.9when treating gender dysphoria in minors:

1.10(1) performing or assisting with sex reassignment surgery or any other surgical procedures

1.11that alters primary or secondary sexual characteristics; and

1.12(2) prescribing, dispensing, or administering puberty blocking hormones or hormone

1.13antagonist therapies.

1.14(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a licensed or regulated health care provider may

1.15continue the prescription, dispensation, or administration for puberty blocking hormones

1.16or hormone antagonist therapies for a minor who is receiving such treatment prior to the

1.17effective date of this act.

1.18EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
