1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to housing; appropriating money for grants to supportive housing providers;
1.3 amending Laws 2023, chapter 37, article 1, section 2, subdivision 18, as amended.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Laws 2023, chapter 37, article 1, section 2, subdivision 18, as amended by Laws
1.6 2024, chapter 127, article 14, section 9, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 18. Supportive Housing 10,000,000 -0-

1.8 (a) This appropriation is for the supportive
1.9 housing program under Minnesota Statutes,
1.10 section 462A.42. This is a onetime
1.11 appropriation.

1.12 (b) Of this amount, \$1,500,000 is for grants
1.13 to United States Department of Housing and
1.14 Urban Development Continuum of Care
1.15 Program grantees for fiscal year 2024 whose
1.16 contracts have expired or will expire before
1.17 December 31, 2026, and have experienced or
1.18 will experience funding gaps. The agency may
1.19 prioritize awards to grantees based on need.
1.20 Notwithstanding the application provisions
1.21 outlined in Minnesota Statutes, section
1.22 462A.42, subdivision 5, and the procurement
1.23 provisions outlined in Minnesota Statutes,

2.1 section 16C.06, subdivisions 1, 2, and 6, the
2.2 agency may award grants to existing and
2.3 previous federal Continuum of Care funding
2.4 recipients. The agency shall make best efforts
2.5 to obligate the appropriation within 120 days
2.6 of July 1, 2026.

2.7 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
