1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256B.073, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 2. Definitions. (a) For purposes of this section, the terms in this subdivision have
1.8 the meanings given them.

1.9 (b) "Electronic visit verification" means the electronic documentation of the:

1.10 (1) type of service performed;

1.11 (2) individual receiving the service;

1.12 (3) date of the service;

1.13 (4) location of the service delivery;

1.14 (5) individual providing the service; and

1.15 (6) time the service begins and ends.

1.16 (c) "Electronic visit verification system" means a system that provides electronic
1.17 verification of services that complies with the 21st Century Cures Act, Public Law 114-255,
1.18 and the requirements of subdivision 3.

1.19 (d) "Service" means one of the following:

- 2.1 (1) personal care assistance services as defined in section 256B.0625, subdivision 19a,  
2.2 and provided according to section 256B.0659;
- 2.3 (2) community first services and supports under section 256B.85;
- 2.4 (3) home health services under section 256B.0625, subdivision 6a; ~~or~~
- 2.5 (4) all services delivered by a provider that is a provider type designated "high-risk" by  
2.6 the commissioner based on the criteria and standards used to designate Medicare providers  
2.7 in Code of Federal Regulations, title 42, section 424.518;
- 2.8 (5) services that are designated "high-risk" by the commissioner;
- 2.9 ~~(4)~~ (6) other medical supplies and equipment or home and community-based services  
2.10 that are required to be electronically verified by the 21st Century Cures Act, Public Law  
2.11 114-255-; or
- 2.12 (7) any other program or service designated by the commissioner.
