1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to environment; exempting veterinary products from the prohibition on

1.3 products containing PFAS; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 116.943,

1.4 subdivision 8.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 116.943, subdivision 8, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 8. **Exemptions.** (a) This section does not apply to:

1.8 (1) a product for which federal law governs the presence of PFAS in the product in a

1.9 manner that preempts state authority;

1.10 (2) a product regulated under section 325F.072 or 325F.075; or

1.11 (3) the sale or resale of a used product.

1.12 (b) Subdivisions 4 and 5 do not apply to a prosthetic or orthotic device or to any product

1.13 that is a medical device ~~or~~ drug, or biologic, or that is otherwise used in a medical or

1.14 veterinary setting or in medical applications regulated by the United States Food and Drug

1.15 Administration or the United States Department of Agriculture.
