1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 8, article 1, section 15, subdivision
1.8 4, as amended by Laws 2020, Fifth Special Session chapter 3, article 5, section 25, is
1.9 amended to read:

1.10 Subd. 4. Rail Grade Separation on Crude Oil
1.11 Rail Corridors 71,124,000

1.12 (a) Of this amount, \$42,262,000 is for a grant
1.13 to the city of Moorhead for environmental
1.14 analysis, design, engineering, removal of an
1.15 existing structure, and construction of a rail
1.16 grade crossing separation in the vicinity of
1.17 21st Street South.

1.18 (b) \$14,100,000 is for a grant to Anoka County
1.19 for environmental analysis, design,
1.20 engineering, removal of an existing structure,
1.21 and construction of a rail grade crossing
1.22 separation at Anoka County State-Aid
1.23 Highway 78, known as Hanson Boulevard, in
1.24 Coon Rapids. Any unspent portion of the

2.1 appropriation under this paragraph may be
 2.2 used by Anoka County for design costs of
 2.3 other rail crossings in Anoka County that are
 2.4 on the commissioner's rail safety priority list.

2.5 (c) Of this amount, \$14,762,000 is for a grant
 2.6 to the city of Red Wing for acquisition of
 2.7 right-of-way, environmental analysis, design,
 2.8 engineering, removal of an existing structure,
 2.9 and construction of a rail grade crossing
 2.10 separation at Sturgeon Lake Road.

2.11 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section
 2.12 16A.642, the bond sale authorization and
 2.13 appropriation of bond proceeds for the project
 2.14 in this paragraph are available until December
 2.15 31, 2024.

2.16 (d) Any unspent portion of this appropriation
 2.17 after completion of a project in this
 2.18 subdivision may be used for grants in
 2.19 accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section
 2.20 219.016.

2.21 (e) Any unspent portion of the amount
 2.22 allocated for paragraph (c) may be used for
 2.23 capital improvements to Sturgeon Lake Road
 2.24 in the area of the rail grade separation project.
