1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256B.0625, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 77. **Intrauterine device removal.** Medical assistance covers the removal of

1.9 intrauterine devices.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2027, or upon federal approval,

1.11 whichever is later. The commissioner of human services shall notify the revisor of statutes

1.12 when federal approval is obtained.

1.13 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATIONS.**

1.14 Subdivision 1. **Medical assistance.** \$..... in fiscal year 2027 is appropriated from the

1.15 general fund to the commissioner of human services for medical assistance coverage of

1.16 intrauterine device removals under Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0625, subdivision 77.
