1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 245A.02, subdivision 6c, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 6c. **Foster care for adults.** "Foster care for adults" means a program operating
1.8 24 hours a day that provides functionally impaired adults with food, lodging, protection,
1.9 supervision, and household ~~services~~ management in a residence, in addition to services
1.10 according to the individual service plans under Minnesota Rules, part 9555.5105, subpart
1.11 18.

1.12 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 245A.02, subdivision 6f, is amended to read:

1.13 Subd. 6f. **Family adult foster care home.** "Family adult foster care home" means an
1.14 adult foster care home:

1.15 (1) that is licensed by the Department of Human Services;

1.16 (2) that is the primary residence of the license holder; and

1.17 (3) in which the license holder is the primary caregiver providing the services listed in
1.18 subdivision 6c.
