1.2 relating to lawful gambling; modifying certain prize and ticket limits; amending

1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 349.211, subdivision 2b.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 349.211, subdivision 2b, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 2b. **Paddlewheel prizes.** (a) The maximum cash prize which may be awarded for

1.7 a paddle ticket is \$70. The maximum value of a merchandise prize which may be awarded

1.8 for a paddle ticket shall not exceed a fair market value of \$200. An organization may not

1.9 sell any paddle ticket for more than ~~\$2~~ \$5.

1.10 (b) "Merchandise prize" does not include gift cards that can be redeemed for cash.
