1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 62V.05, subdivision 7, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 7. **Agreements; consultation.** (a) The board shall:

1.7 (1) establish and maintain an agreement with the commissioner of human services for

1.8 cost allocation and services regarding eligibility determinations and enrollment for public

1.9 health care programs that use a modified adjusted gross income standard to determine

1.10 program eligibility. The board may establish and maintain an agreement with the

1.11 commissioner of human services for other services;

1.12 (2) establish and maintain an agreement with the commissioners of commerce and health

1.13 for services regarding enforcement of MNsure certification requirements for health plans

1.14 and dental plans offered through MNsure. The board may establish and maintain agreements

1.15 with the commissioners of commerce and health for other services; and

1.16 (3) establish interagency agreements to transfer funds to other state agencies for their

1.17 costs related to implementing and operating MNsure, excluding medical assistance allocatable

1.18 costs.

1.19 (b) The board shall consult with the commissioners of commerce and health regarding

1.20 the operations of MNsure.

1.21 (c) The board shall consult with Indian tribes and organizations regarding the operation

1.22 of MNsure.

2.1 ~~(d) Beginning March 15, 2016, and each March 15 thereafter, the board shall submit a~~
2.2 ~~report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the committees in the senate and house~~
2.3 ~~of representatives with primary jurisdiction over commerce, health, and human services on~~
2.4 ~~all the agreements entered into with the chief information officer of the Department of~~
2.5 ~~Information Technology Services, or the commissioners of human services, health, or~~
2.6 ~~commerce in accordance with this subdivision. The report shall include the agency in which~~
2.7 ~~the agreement is with; the time period of the agreement; the purpose of the agreement; and~~
