**OFFICIAL STATUS**

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to civil liability; limiting liability for all corporate donations for death or  
1.3 injury to a participant resulting from the inherent risks of livestock activities;  
1.4 amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 604A.12, subdivision 2.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 604A.12, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 2. **Immunity from liability; livestock events.** A ~~nonprofit~~ corporation, association,  
1.8 or organization, or a person or other entity donating services, livestock, facilities, or  
1.9 equipment for the use of a ~~nonprofit~~ corporation, association, or organization, is not liable  
1.10 for the death of or an injury to a participant resulting from the inherent risks of livestock  
1.11 activities.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2025, and applies to causes  
1.13 of action accruing on or after that date.
