33.17 Minnesota Statutes, section 504B.345, was formerly codified as Minnesota Statutes, section
33.18 566.09. Minnesota Statutes, section 566.09, was amended by Laws 1991, chapter 193,
33.19 section 2, to add subdivision 2, which related only to residential rental property forfeitures
33.20 and the expedited eviction process under Minnesota Statutes, section 609.5317, subdivision
33.21 1 (which in turn, had been enacted in the prior year by Laws 1989, chapter 305, section 7).
33.22 Minnesota Statutes, section 566.09, subdivision 2, was later recodified as Minnesota Statutes,

33.31 section 45. The repealer was printed in the main text of Minnesota Statutes, and the
33.32 amendment was printed as a note. This repealer allows the revisor to remove the note
33.33 containing the amendment.

34.1 Subd. 19. **Conflict resolution.** This subdivision resolves a conflict between two enacted
34.2 laws. Minnesota Statutes, section 256G.09, subdivisions 4 and 5, were amended by Laws
34.3 2025, chapter 21, sections 56 and 57. Minnesota Statute, section 256G.09, subdivisions 4
