1.8	Subd. 12a. Transfers of wine. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 12, the
1.9	holder of an off-sale intoxicating liquor license may transfer wine from one licensed premises
1.10	to another provided that:
1.11	(1) the license for the transferring and receiving premises are held by the same licensee;
1.12	(2) the licensee notifies the wholesaler from whom the wine was purchased and the
1.13	Division of Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement of the Division of Public Safety, in writing,
1.14	of the transfer; and
1.15	(3) only one transfer is made from a licensed premises in a three-month period.
