

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government finance; making appropriation reductions to higher
1.3 education; amending Laws 2010, First Special Session chapter 1, article 5,
1.4 sections 4; 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2010, First Special Session chapter 1, article 5, section 4, is amended
1.7 to read:

1.8 Sec. 4. **BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE**
1.9 **MINNESOTA STATE COLLEGES AND**
1.10 **UNIVERSITIES** \$ -0- \$ (50,000,000)

1.11 \$2,079,000 of the reduction in 2011 is from
1.12 the central offices and shared services unit
1.13 appropriation. None of these reductions may
1.14 be charged back or allocated to the campuses.

1.15 \$47,921,000 of the reduction in 2011
1.16 is from the operations and maintenance
1.17 appropriation.

1.18 For fiscal years 2012 and 2013, the base for
1.19 operations and maintenance is ~~\$580,802,000~~
1.20 \$532,881,000 each year.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

For fiscal years 2012 and 2013, the base for
operations and maintenance is ~~\$578,370,000~~
\$533,764,000 each year.

Subd. 3. **Special Appropriations**

(a) **Agriculture and Extension Service** -0- (3,858,000)

(b) **Health Sciences** -0- (389,000)

\$26,000 of the 2011 reduction is from the St.
Cloud family practice residency program.

(c) **Institute of Technology** -0- (102,000)

(d) **System Special** -0- (454,000)

(e) **University of Minnesota and Mayo
Foundation Partnership** -0- (591,000)
