1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; permitting municipalities to authorize Sunday off-sale of
1.3 intoxicating liquors; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 340A.504,
1.4 subdivision 4, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 340A.504, subdivision 4, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 4. **Intoxicating liquor; off-sale.** Except as provided in subdivision 4a, no
1.9 sale of intoxicating liquor may be made by an off-sale licensee:

- 1.10 (1) on Sundays;
- 1.11 (2) before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m. on Monday through Saturday;
- 1.12 (3) on Thanksgiving Day;
- 1.13 (4) on Christmas Day, December 25; or
- 1.14 (5) after 8:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve, December 24.

1.15 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 340A.504, is amended by adding a
1.16 subdivision to read:

1.17 Subd. 4a. **Sunday sales; local control.** The governing body of a municipality may
1.18 authorize within its jurisdiction, the sale of intoxicating liquor by an off-sale licensee
1.19 between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Sunday.
