1.5	Section 1. [256S.01] OFFICE OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICES.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Creation. A state Office of Eligibility Services is created.
1.7	Subd. 2. Director. (a) The office shall be under the direction of a director who shall be
1.8	appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, for a term ending on
1.9	June 30 of the sixth calendar year after appointment. Senate confirmation of the director
1.10	shall be as provided by section 15.066. The director shall appoint deputies to serve in the
1.11	office as necessary to fulfill the duties of the office. The director may delegate to a
1.12	subordinate employee the exercise of a specified statutory power or duty, subject to the
1.13	control of the director. Every delegation must be by written order filed with the secretary
1.14	of state.
1.15	(b) The director shall be in the unclassified service, but may be removed only for cause.
