The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources Policy

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to environmental health; prohibiting the sale of certain products  
1.3 containing triclosan or similar antibacterial compounds; proposing coding for  
1.4 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 116.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[116.3801] CERTAIN ANTIBACTERIAL PRODUCTS.**

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Generally.** No person shall offer for sale in Minnesota any personal  
1.8 care products, cosmetics, or cleaning products containing triclosan, triclocarban, or  
1.9 similar antibacterial compounds.

1.10 Subd. 2. **Exceptions.** This section does not prohibit the sale of products that are  
1.11 used solely in medical facilities.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2014.
