1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education; providing for possession and use of sunscreen at school;  
1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 121A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [121A.223] POSSESSION AND USE OF SUNSCREEN.

1.6 A school district must allow a student to possess and apply a topical sunscreen product  
1.7 during the school day, while on school property, or at a school-sponsored event without a  
1.8 prescription, physician's note, or other documentation from a licensed health care  
1.9 professional. A school district may adopt a policy related to student possession and use of  
1.10 sunscreen consistent with this section. Nothing in this section requires school personnel to  
1.11 provide sunscreen or assist students in applying sunscreen.
