- 1.2 relating to traffic regulations; limiting placement of crosswalks at a roundabout;
- 1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 169.06, by adding a subdivision.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 169.06, is amended by adding a subdivision
- 1.6 to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 6a. **Roundabout.** (a) A road authority, as defined in section 169.224, subdivision
- 1.8 1, must not establish a crosswalk within 100 feet of a roundabout.
- 1.9 (b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to a crosswalk that is:
- 1.10 (1) controlled by pedestrian-control signals; or
- 1.11 (2) established prior to the effective date of this section, until reconstruction of the
- 1.12 roundabout or road.
