

A bill for an act
relating to capital investment; modifying appropriations and reducing a
corresponding bond sale authorization for the Old Cedar Avenue Bridge;
amending Laws 2006, chapter 258, section 17, subdivision 8, as amended; Laws
2008, chapter 365, section 4, subdivision 3, as amended; Laws 2010, chapter
189, section 16, subdivision 4.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 2006, chapter 258, section 17, subdivision 8, as amended by Laws
2008, chapter 179, section 64, and Laws 2008, chapter 365, section 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. **Metropolitan Regional Parks Capital**
Improvements 35,362,000

For the cost of improvements and betterments
of a capital nature and acquisition by the
council and local government units of
regional recreational open-space lands in
accordance with the council's policy plan
as provided in Minnesota Statutes, section
473.147. Priority must be given to park
rehabilitation and land acquisition projects.

\$300,000 is for a grant to the city of
Bloomington ~~to renovate~~ for environmental
analysis and review, design, and construction
of a multimodal trail connection across Long
Meadow Lake in the vicinity of the old Cedar
Avenue bridge and for development of a

2.1 segment of the Minnesota Valley State Trail
2.2 from Fort Snelling State Park to the Long
2.3 Meadow Lake crossing to serve as a hiking
2.4 and bicycling trail connection.

2.5 \$6,000,000 is for a grant to the county
2.6 of Dakota to acquire land for a regional

2.11 \$1,800,000 is for a grant to the city of

2.26 \$2,500,000 is for a grant to the Minneapolis
2.27 Park and Recreation Board to mitigate
2.28 flooding at Lake of the Isles in the city
2.29 of Minneapolis. The grant must be used
2.30 for shoreline stabilization and restoration,
2.31 dredging, wetland replacement, and other
2.32 infrastructure improvements necessary to
2.33 deal with the 1997 flood damage and to
2.34 prevent future flooding.
