1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. [162.082] TOWN ROAD AND BRIDGE ASSISTANCE ACCOUNT.
1.7	(a) A town road and bridge assistance account is created in the special revenue fund.
1.8	The account consists of funds as provided by law, and any other money donated, allotted,
1.9	transferred, or otherwise provided to the account. Funds in the account are appropriated to
1.10	the commissioner and shall be allocated so that each town receives the percentage that the
1.11	total lane miles of town roads in the town bears to the total lane miles of town roads in the
1.12	state.
1.13	(b) The commissioner shall allocate funds in the account as provided in paragraph (a)
1.14	and notify the commissioner of revenue. Following notification, the commissioner of revenue
1.15	shall distribute the specified funds to towns. Any appropriation to the commissioner of
1.16	transportation under this section is available to the commissioner of revenue for the purposes
1.17	specified in this paragraph.
1.18	(c) Funds from the account may be expended by the town only for the construction,
1.19	reconstruction, and maintenance of town roads and bridges within the town.
