1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 403.03, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Emergency response services.** Services available through a 911 system

1.7 must include police, firefighting, and emergency medical and ambulance services. Other

1.8 emergency and civil defense services may be incorporated into the 911 system at the

1.9 discretion of the public agency operating the public safety answering point. The 911 system

1.10 ~~may~~ shall include a referral to mental health crisis teams, ~~where available~~ when appropriate.

1.11 Sec. 2. **TITLE.**

1.12 This act shall be known as "Travis's Law."
