1.3 document for vehicle title registration; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 168A.085, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 3. Consular identification card. A valid and unexpired consular identification
1.9 card issued to the applicant by the recognized consulate of a jurisdiction other than the
1.10 United States is a primary document for purposes of Minnesota Rules, part 7410.0400, and
1.11 successor rules, when the applicant is an individual who is applying as the owner for a
1.12 vehicle title or registration.
