1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing a license in St. Paul.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **CITY OF ST. PAUL; INTOXICATING MALT LIQUOR.**

1.5 Notwithstanding any law, ordinance, or charter provision to the contrary, the city of
1.6 St. Paul may authorize a holder of an on-sale wine license issued pursuant to Minnesota
1.7 Statutes, section 340A.404, subdivision 5, who is also licensed to sell 3.2 percent malt
1.8 liquors at on-sale pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.411, to sell intoxicating
1.9 malt liquors at on-sale without an additional license.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the St. Paul City
1.11 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
