

A resolution

memorializing the Governor of the State of California concerning Kathleen Ann Soliah.

WHEREAS, Minnesota is part of the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision;
and

WHEREAS, the compact requires cooperation among states concerning the acceptance of
parole transfers; and

WHEREAS, the transfer determination rests with the State of California; and

WHEREAS, Kathleen Ann Soliah was convicted of the crime of accessory to murder
during a bank robbery; and

WHEREAS, Kathleen Ann Soliah was convicted of attempt to murder Los Angeles police
officers with bombs; and

WHEREAS, these crimes were committed in the State of California; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota that it memorializes the
Governor of the State of California that Minnesota strongly urges the State of California to
retain jurisdiction over Kathleen Ann Soliah during the period of her probation and to allow
her to remain in California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota is
directed to prepare copies of this memorial and transmit them to the Governor of the State of
California.
