As used in this section: 1.7 (1) "services" means the provision of physical, emotional, financial, or other care, 18 assistance, counseling, advice, or services; and 19

1.10 (2) "program" means the Minnesota National Guard beyond the yellow ribbon

1.11 program.

1.12 Subd. 2. Civil immunity. (a) A person who, while participating in any capacity in

1.13 the program, provides services to an active or reserve service member or to an immediate

- 1.14 <u>family member of the service member before, during, or after the service member's</u>
- 1.15 mobilization or deployment for a contingency operation ordered by a proper military

1.16 authority is not liable for damages resulting from the acts or omissions by that person in

- 1.17 providing the services, unless the act or omission is willful and wanton or reckless.
- 1.18 (b) A recipient of services provided by a person participating in any capacity in
- 1.19 the program is not liable for damages incurred by the person in the course of providing
- 1.20 the services, unless the damage is the result of a willful and wanton or reckless act or

1.21 omission of the recipient.

1.22 <u>Subd. 3.</u> Exception. This section does not apply to a person who provides services 1.23 to an active or reserve service member or to an immediate family member of the service

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- 2.1 <u>member during the course of the person's regular employment and for which the person</u>
- 2.2 <u>receives compensation.</u>
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment
- 2.4 <u>and applies to damages incurred on or after that date.</u>
