1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to transportation; authorizing individuals operating motor vehicles bearing
1.3 veteran special license plates to use priced, high-occupancy, and dynamic shoulder
1.4 lanes; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 160.93, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section. 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 160.93, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 6. Veterans. (a) A person may operate a single-occupant vehicle in a priced lane,
1.9 designated high-occupancy vehicle lane, or dynamic shoulder lane if the person is operating
1.10 a motor vehicle bearing a special plate issued under section 168.123, 168.1235, 168.124,
1.11 168.125, or 168.1255.

1.12 (b) The commissioner must not impose a monthly service or subscription fee, a per-trip
1.13 charge, or other use fee to operate a motor vehicle as provided under this subdivision. The
1.14 commissioner may require use of a toll-collection device for vehicles operated under this
1.15 subdivision. If the commissioner requires a toll-collection device to use a priced lane,
1.16 designated high-occupancy vehicle lane, or dynamic shoulder lane under this subdivision,
1.17 the registered owner of the vehicle bearing a special plate listed under paragraph (a) must
1.18 pay the cost to obtain the toll-collection device.
