1.6	Section 1. TERMINATION OF NORTHSTAR COMMUTER RAIL SERVICE.

1.7	Subdivision 1. Definitions. (a) For purposes of this section, the following terms have
1.8	the meanings given.
1.9	(b) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of transportation.
1.10	(c) "Council" means the Metropolitan Council.
1.11	(d) "Northstar" means the Northstar Commuter Rail line that provides rail passenger
1.12	service between downtown Minneapolis and Big Lake, including stops in Fridley, Coon

2.2	shall immediately terminate any lease, license, assignment, right of access, or other agreement
