1.6	Section 1. MINNESOTA SEX OFFENDER PROGRAM; ST. PETER.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$18,288,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the commissioner of administration to design, renovate, furnish, and equip the second
1.9	phase of a multiphase project to develop additional residential, program, activity, and
1.10	ancillary facilities for the Minnesota sex offender program on the lower campus of the St.
1.11	Peter Regional Treatment Center. This appropriation includes money to design, renovate,
1.12	furnish, and equip: the north wing of Green Acres; the west, south, and north wings of
1.13	Sunrise; and the Tomlinson Building. This appropriation also includes money to replace or
