1.10	research-based solutions through:
1.11	(1) implementation of a watershed scale carp management plan and additional research
1.12	focused on site-specific method refinement and evaluation;
1.13	(2) creation of a long-term monitoring program with state and local partners that evaluates
1.14	the feasibility of whole-lake zebra mussel control projects and the development of criteria
