2.1 (b) ~~By majority vote of each house of the legislature, the legislature may terminate a~~
2.2 ~~peacetime emergency extending beyond 30 days. A peacetime emergency must not be~~
2.3 ~~continued, through an extension of the original order or through a new order effective within~~
2.4 ~~seven days of the expiration of the peacetime emergency under the original order, more~~
2.5 ~~than 30 days without approval of a majority vote of each house of the legislature. If the~~
2.6 governor determines a need to extend the peacetime emergency declaration beyond 30 days
2.7 and the legislature is not sitting in session, the governor must issue a call immediately
2.8 convening both houses of the legislature. Nothing in this section limits the governor's
2.9 authority over or command of the National Guard as described in the Military Code, chapters
2.10 190 to 192A, and required by the Minnesota Constitution, article V, section 3.
