1.6	Section 1. APPROPRIATION AND BOND SALE AUTHORIZATION.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	account to the commissioner of transportation for construction of two highway-rail grade
1.9	separations, both in the city of Ramsey, at:
1.10	(1) the intersection of Anoka County Road 56, also known as Ramsey Boulevard,
1.11	with the Burlington Northern Santa Fe mainline; and
1.12	(2) the intersection of Anoka County Road 57, also known as Sunfish Lake
1.13	Boulevard, with the Burlington Northern Santa Fe mainline.
1.14	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
