1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 3.012, is amended to read:

1.6 **3.012 LEGISLATIVE DAY.**

1.7 ~~A~~ For the purposes of article IV, section 12, of the Minnesota Constitution, a
1.8 legislative day is a day when either house of the legislature is called to order gives any bill
1.9 a second or third reading, adopts a rule of procedure or organization, elects a university
1.10 regent, or confirms a gubernatorial appointment. A legislative day begins at seven o'clock
1.11 a.m. and continues until seven o'clock a.m. of the following calendar day.
