1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; appropriating money to the commissioner of
1.3 administration to develop a road map for implementing an enterprise grants
1.4 management system.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. GRANTS ADMINISTRATION OVERSIGHT; FEASIBILITY STUDY.

1.7 (a) \$735,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$201,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from
1.8 the general fund to the commissioner of administration to develop a road map for
1.9 implementing an enterprise grants management system. This is a onetime appropriation.

1.10 (b) The appropriation provided by this section must be used to assess the viability of
1.11 implementing a single grants management system for executive agencies. If the results of
1.12 the study determine an enterprise system is feasible, the study must further include:

1.13 (1) an analysis of available technology options;

1.14 (2) recommended changes to the state's organizational model, operational controls, and
1.15 processes;

1.16 (3) staffing and other resource needs;

1.17 (4) high level system requirements;

1.18 (5) estimated costs; and

1.19 (6) an implementation road map.
