| 1.7               | Subd. 4. <b>Board.</b> (a) The league must have <u>at least</u> a 20-member governing board.  |
| 1.8               | (1) The governor must appoint four members according to section 15.0597. Each of the  |
| 1.9               | four appointees must be a parent. At least one of them must be an American Indian, an   |
| 1.10              | Asian, a Black, or a Hispanic.  |
| 1.11              | (2) The Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals must appoint two of its  |
| 1.12              | members.  |
| 1.13              | (3) The remaining 14 members must be selected according to league bylaws the league's   |
| 1.14              | constitution.   |
| 1.15              | (b) The terms, compensation, removal of members, and the filling of membership  |
| 1.16              | vacancies are governed by section 15.0575, except that the four-year terms begin on August  |
