1.6	Section 1. CARVER COUNTY; REGIONAL RESIDENTIAL CRISIS

1.8	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$1,250,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9	to the commissioner of human services for a grant to Carver County to design, construct,
1.10	furnish, and equip a facility in the city of Chaska to provide regional residential crisis
1.11	stabilization services subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695. This appropriation
