1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2018, chapter 214, article 1, section 21, subdivision 28, as amended by
1.7 Laws 2019, chapter 2, article 2, section 6, is amended to read:

2.1 Notwithstanding the primary focus as a
2.2 workforce training facility described in this
2.3 subdivision, a portion of the Plato site may be
2.4 used for child care facilities open to the public
2.5 but is primarily intended to improve
2.6 programming outcomes for students and
2.7 participants of the training programs. A
2.8 portion of both the Plato and Sycamore sites
2.9 may include on-site supportive services to
2.10 assist the participants in training programs to
2.11 secure housing, mental health services, adult
2.12 basic education, and health care enrollment
2.13 and access. The ~~city of St. Paul~~ county may
2.14 enter into a lease or management agreement
2.15 with a nonprofit corporation for either or both
2.16 of these facilities under Minnesota Statutes,
2.17 section 16A.695.

2.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
